Footwear

Black shoes with flat heel. Boots are not appropriate footwear for school. If it is a wet or cold day and your child needs to wear wellies or warm boots to travel to school, please make sure they have school shoes to change into.

Jewellery

On health and safety grounds we do not allow children to wear jewellery in our school. Jewellery must not be worn although children with pierced ears may wear simple studs

Make up and Cosmetics

Make-up and cosmetics are not considered appropriate or consistent with our school uniform. The school does not permit such products to be worn by any children. Long hair needs to be tied back with suitable hair accessories.

PE Clothing for boys and girls

It is essential that children are correctly dressed for P.E and Games lessons. Children must have a change of clothing and footwear.

- Coloured T-shirt in their team colour Red/Navy/Bottle Green/Yellow with school logo (each child will be allocated a Team when they join our school)
- ✓ Navy blue shorts or gym skirt
- ✓ Rubber soled plimsolls
- ✓ Tracksuits or sweatshirts and leggings for games in colder weather
- ✓ Trainers for outdoor games
- ✓ Long hair must be tied back
- ✓ Ear rings should be removed or covered with surgical tape

Indoor and outdoor kits should be kept in school and will be sent home at the end of each half term for washing.

Please Note: PE kits should be fully named.

Swimming

Swimming trunks or a swimming costume and a swimming cap (caps aren't compulsory) need to be brought in for Year 3 - more details available when necessary.

School Bags

Due to restrictions on space please keep school bags to a size similar to that of our book bags. We really cannot accommodate large rucksacks in the cloakrooms.

Please ensure that all items of clothing, bags, water bottles and lunch boxes are named so that if they do get lost they can be returned, thank you.
